# Ryder Cup Matches

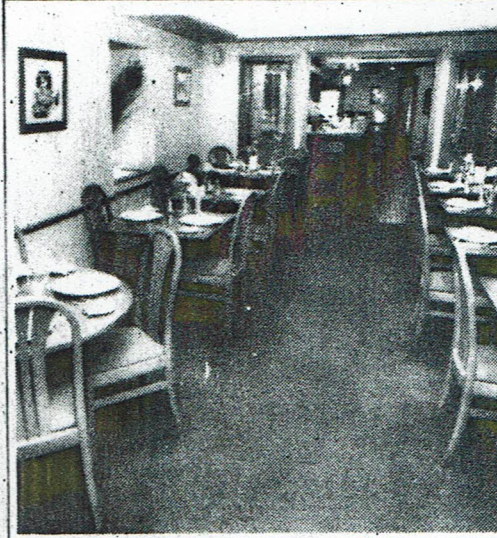

Tony Grana's is open Tuesdays through Thursdays 5:00 to 10:00, Fridays and Saturdays from 5:00 to 11:00, and Sundays from 5:00 to 9:00. They're closed Mondays and reservations are recommended on the weekend.
